Plataforma de maior produção atualmente da Petrobras, o FPSO Carioca completa um ano de operação

O FPSO Carioca, plataforma que produz no campo de Sépia, no pré-sal da Bacia de Santos, completou um ano de operação na última terça-feira (23/08). Neste período, o navio-plataforma alcançou uma produção acumulada de cerca de 39 milhões de barris de óleo (produção operada). Atualmente é a maior plataforma no Brasil em termos de complexidade e de produção, com cerca de 175 mil barris/dia produzidos, volume próximo à capacidade máxima projetada, de 180 mil barris/dia.

A unidade tem também capacidade diária de processamento de 6 milhões de m3 de gás natural. Na atual fase, o gás associado é utilizado para geração de energia elétrica para consumo próprio e o excedente é reinjetado no reservatório para manutenção de pressão através de dois poços injetores. A previsão é de que até o final de 2022 o FPSO exporte gás.

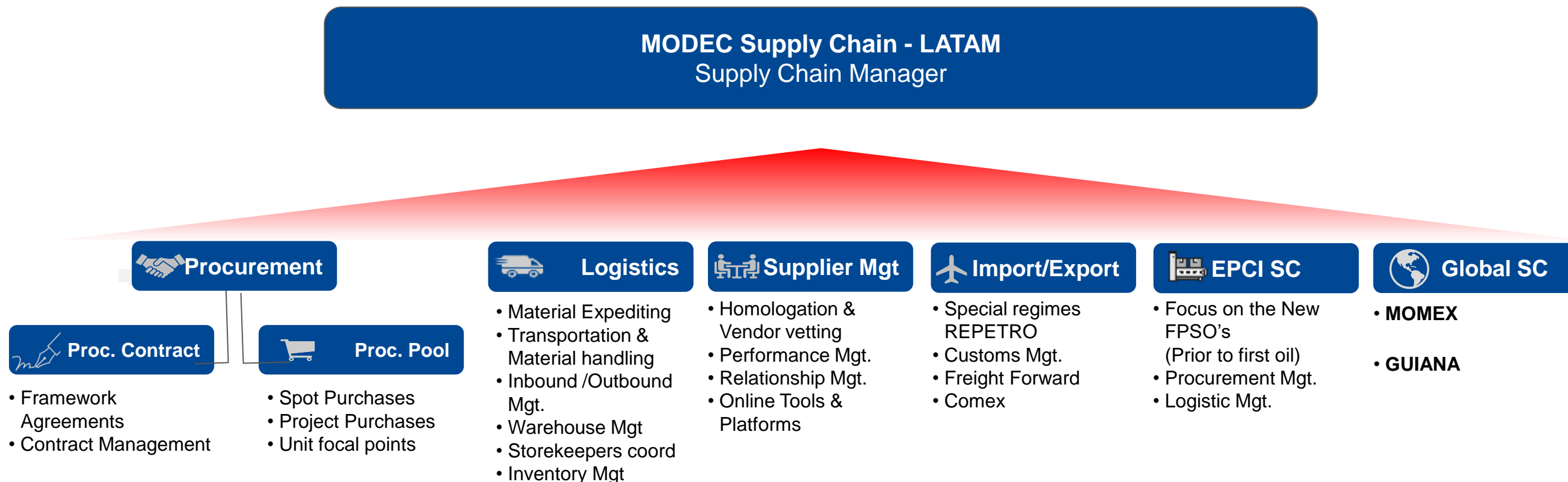

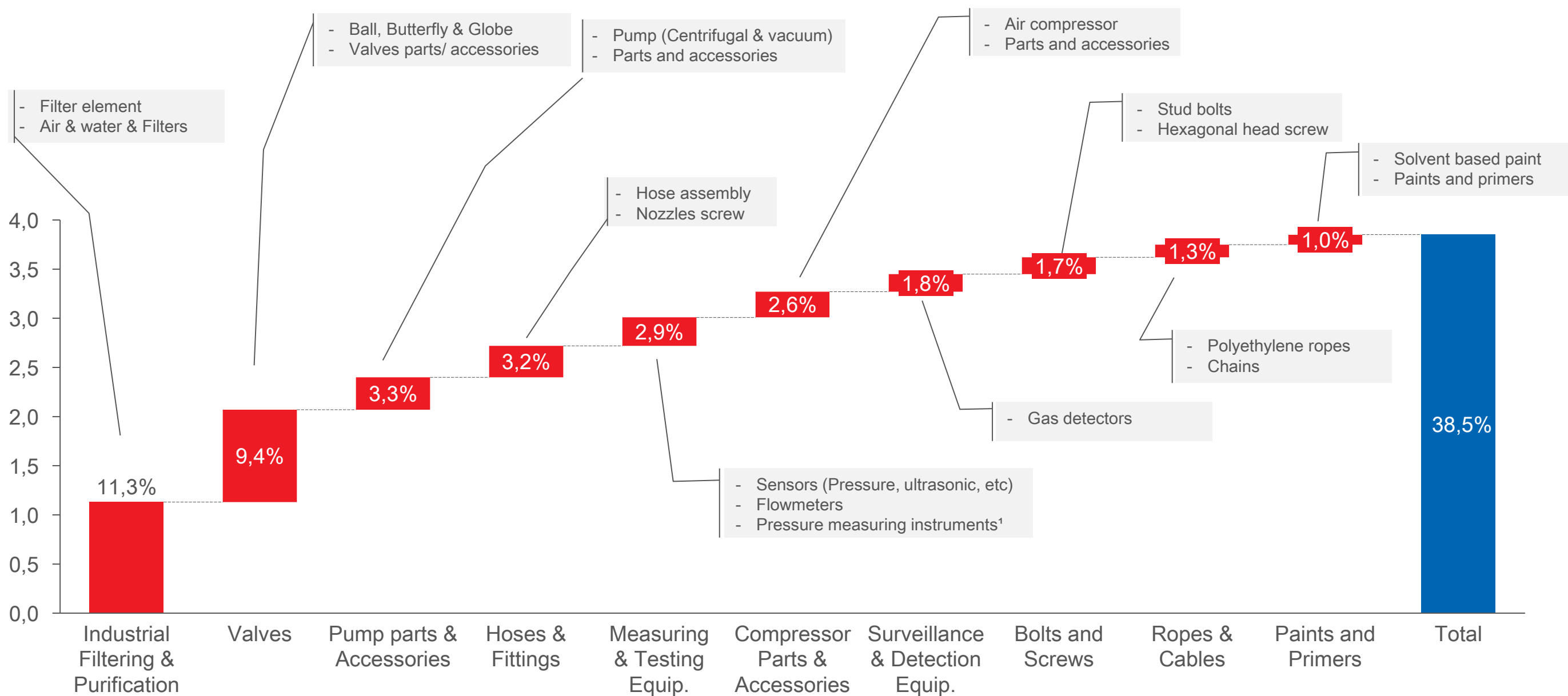

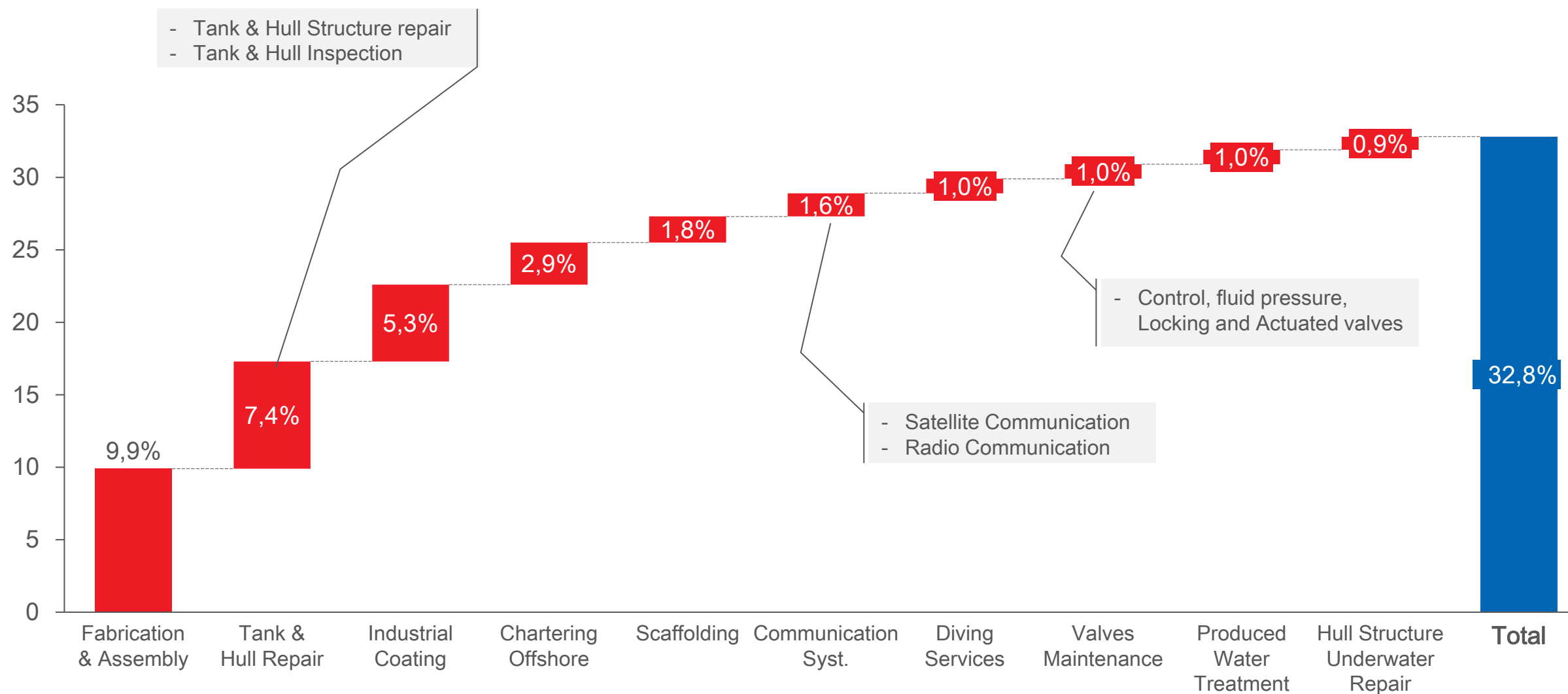
Organization Chart

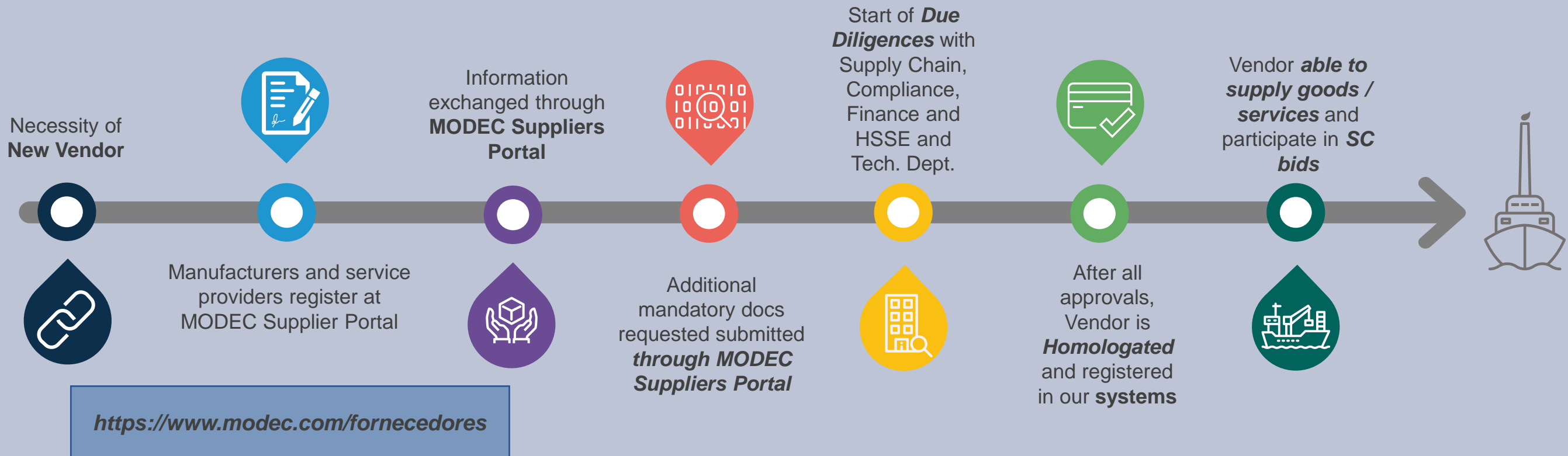
SERVICES Challenges

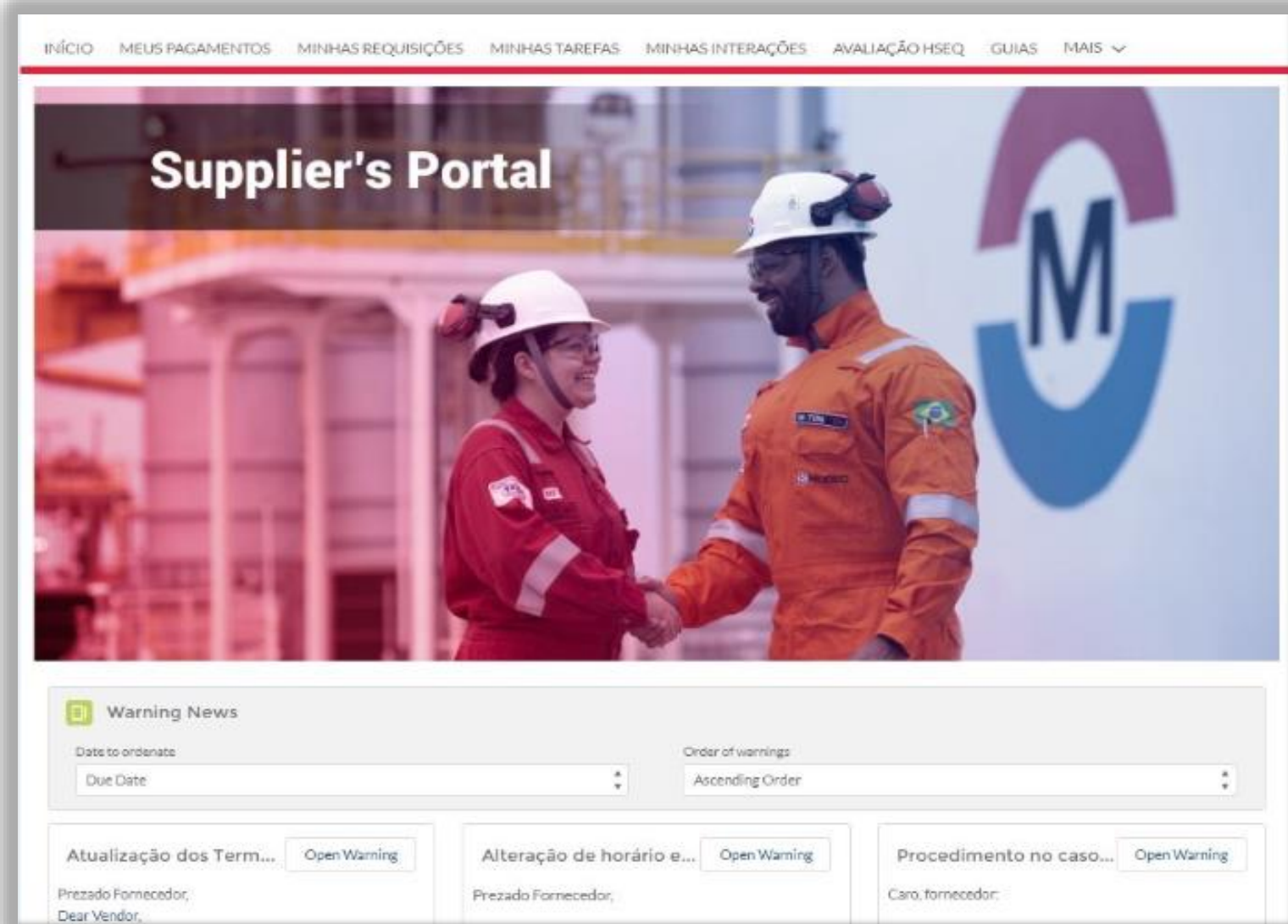
